Communiqué to the students, parents and stakeholders of 30th May 2017

Following the comprehensive audit which took place on 10th October 2016 and the subsequent decisions by the Minister of Education of 10th March 2017 to temporarily suspend the programs of Computer Science, Biotechnology, Biomedical Laboratory Sciences and Civil Engineering;

Considering the follow up assessment that took place from 3rd to 5th May 2017 and subsequent recommendations of 30th May 2017, the Minister of education commended the effort made by INES-Ruhengeri and the following table shows the detailed recommendations to be addressed.
