Do you want to pursue studies in *Land Survey, Civil Engineering, Biomedical Laboratory Science, Food Biotechnologies, Plant Biotechnologies, Land Administration and Management, Computer Science* or *Statistics Applied to Economy* at INES-Ruhengeri? Do you lack the funds/money to finance your studies? **The great news is that Chancen International Rwanda in partnership with INES-Ruhengeri have made the CHANCEN Income Share Agreement (ISA) available for those in need of financial aid.** The CHANCEN *Income Share Agreement (ISA)* covers your education cost during your study period, and once you graduate you will be expected to pay back if you are employed.

The following are criteria for selecting the admissible candidates:

1. Being a Rwandan
2. Being female is an advantage
3. Having an Advanced Certificate of Education in the subjects of Science with Math option in Civil Engineering and Land Survey and Biology and Chemistry options in Biomedical Laboratory Science, Food and Plant Biotechnologies and related disciplines is admissible to the above mentioned departments where the candidate should have the minimum aggregate of 35/73. Those who studied secondary school abroad will present a certificate of equivalence.

The application file must comprise:

1. The certificate of secondary School as mentioned above;
2. National ID
3. One Coloured passport photo

Interested students should apply online at www.ines.ac.rw and upload the application documents. The deadline to apply for this financial support is on **30th July 2022 by 5 PM.**

N.B: Those who will be guaranteed CHANCEN's financial support will be communicated to by INES-Ruhengeri and will start the class with the September intake. They will be required to attend a CHANCEN Workshop with their guardians before the date of starting classes.
