

Mobility for learners and staff – Higher Education Student and Staff Mobility

CALL FOR APPLICATION

The Rheinische Fachhochschule Köln (RFH), University of Applied Science Cologne has identified the INES-Ruhengeri as its partner. The reason is that INES-Ruhengeri is one of the very few universities of applied sciences in Africa and therefore particularly suitable for cooperation with RFH. Thus, INES-Ruhengeri has signed an Inter-institutional agreement 2019-2022 with ERASMUS+K107. It is in this line that INES staff doing Master's or PhD programmes from all the departments and students interested from Biomedical Laboratory Sciences and Computer Science are requested to apply for research/traineeship or internship in Germany's Universities.

1. Students' internship

The concerned students will go for 4 months. They can go for their dissertation writing with the supervision of the Professors from RFH;

They can combine the writing with industrial or clinical attachment and/or attending a specific course;

Students from Biomedical Laboratory Sciences and Computer Science are encouraged to apply as the supervisors are guaranteed;

Selection criteria

- Having at least 14.00/20 in the previous years (levels);
- Having passed written and oral ad hoc exams
- Having Committed to come back home after the internship period;
- Having a research proposal accepted by the Department for final year dissertation;
- Mastering in English Language
- Having introduction to German Language B1 is an added value.

2. Staffs' traineeship/research

They will go for a traineeship or research for Master or PhD programme in one of the following domains: Business, administration and law, Health and Information and Communication Technologies.

The concerned staff will go for 1 month;

They can combine the research writing and attending a training;

INES will entrust its teachers moving to Germany with a series of objectives to be achieved during the training period;

Staffs conducting researches for Master or PhD programmes are encouraged to apply.

Selection criteria

- Having developed a research proposal accepted by his/her supervisor;
- Having introduction to German Language B1 is an added value;
- Having committed to come back to INES-Ruhengeri after the training/research.

For the selected candidates, the International Office-Welcome Unit of the RFH will provide students and teachers with assistance before and during their stay in Cologne:

- Visa Request
- Acceptance letter
- Health insurance
- Stay permit
- Registration to classes and exams
- Learning agreement
- Transcript of records
- Official communication with home universities
- Looking for accommodation, and
- Other living expenses

The deadline to apply is 7th August 2020. Each student is requested to submit one pdf file of transcripts of level 1, 2 and 3 and research proposal containing the first 3 chapters on inesruhengeri@yahoo.fr, copy to egasirabo@gmail.com . The lecturers will submit only research proposal to the above emails.

Only students and staff selected by INES–Ruhengeri will apply for the scholarship using the application form that will be available on INES website: www.ines.ac.rw
