Requirements for Post-doc scholarship

- Applicants for a Post Doc scholarship are supposed to apply with a formulated idea on research (aimed at formulating a research proposal) or transfer projects (aimed at developing a didactical/methodological concept) (2000 words maximum)
- Applications need to relate to the aims of the ACCESS project, i.e. entrepreneurship capacity building, employability research and promotion, e-learning and HEI-business linkages
- Detailed curriculum vitae, certified academic credentials, proof of enrollment in a university in 2020.

Requirements for Students scholarship

- Applicants for student scholarships need to hand in either an idea for research (community problem oriented) or an innovative business idea/prototype. The description should be between 1500 -2000 words
- Applicants for student scholarships should possess at least 14.5/20 marks in the last academic year, speak English fluently, be ready to work under stress and deliver on time.
- Detailed curriculum vitae, certified academic credentials, proof of enrollment in a university in 2020.
